Regular monthly meeting of the Board of Supervisors, Town of Princeton called to order at 7:00 pm by Chairman Weckwerth. Open meeting laws met through posting and publication. Motion Dan Kuglin/Gary Anderson to approve agenda. All ayes. None opposed. Motion carried. Motion Dan Kuglin/Gary Anderson to approve minutes of the July 8, 2025 regular meeting as posted. All ayes. None opposed. Motion carried.

Treasurer's Report – Treasurer Wagner gives report. Motion Dan Kuglin/Gary Anderson to approve treasurer's report and submit for audit. All ayes. None opposed. Motion carried. General Account: \$471,697.36; Recycling Account: 43,529.94; Road Construction: \$179,817.61; Equipment Fund: \$0; Fire Equipment Fund: \$11, 823.89; Revaluation Fund: \$16,673.60.

Maintenance Supervisor Report – Chairman Weckwerth gives report. Multiple trees have fallen in various places in the town. Brush work was done on south side of Beyers Cove. Pot hole material has been depleted. Terrace area ditches and landfill have been cut.

Public Appearances – None.

Payment of Claims – Bill was received from Northeast Asphalt for Old Green Lake Road. Motion Allan Weckwerth/Dan Kuglin to borrow \$400,000 from National Exchange Bank for the Old Green Lake Road project. All ayes. None opposed. Motion carried. Motion Gary Anderson/Dan Kuglin to pay claims as submitted. All ayes. None opposed. Motion carried.

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Review and adopt Green Lake County Comprehensive Plan Map – Map was reviewed and discussed. Motion Allan Weckwerth/Dan Kuglin to formally approve draft map as reviewed and changed. All ayes. None opposed. Motion carried. Map will be returned to Green Lake County.

Legal action on Teska property on Fox River Drive -- Property owner refused service. Chairman Weckwerth reads letter sent to Mr. Teska from Lee Turonie of Dempsey Law, Town of Princeton attorney. Motion Allan Weckwerth/Dan Kuglin to take legal action against property owner Aaron Teska of N4529 Fox River Drive to remove obstructions in the right of way and the gravel. All ayes. None opposed.

No parking ordinance in town – Town attorney is requesting we adopt a parking ordinance. Discussion held. No action taken.

Chairman's Report and Correspondence – Radtke Construction barge on west end of the lake is discussed. The DNR ordered a cease and desist order on July 9, 2026. Green Lake County Clean Sweep is Friday, August 14, 2026.

Clerk's Report and Correspondence – There were 422 voters at the Partisan Primary Election on August 11, 2026. The next election is the General Election on Tuesday, November 3, 2026, from 7:00 am to 8:00 pm.

Next Meeting Date – Fire budget meeting is August 19, 2026, at 7:00 pm. Fire District meeting is September 2, 2026 at 7:00 pm. Next regular town board meeting is Wednesday, September 9, 2026 at 7:00 pm.
