## \*MINUTES

February 11, 2026

Regular monthly meeting of the Board of Supervisors, Town of Princeton, called to order by Chairman Weckwerth. Open meeting law requirement met through posting and publication. Motion Dan Kuglin/Gary Anderson to approve agenda. All ayes. None opposed. Motion carried. Motion Dan Kuglin/Gary Anderson to approve minutes of the January 14, 2026 meeting minutes as published. All ayes. None opposed. Motion carried.

Treasurer's Report – Treasurer Wagner reads report. Motion Dan Kuglin/Gary Anderson to submit treasurer's report for audit. All ayes. None opposed. Motion carried. General Account: \$370,516.96; Recycling Account: \$1,947.92; Road Construction: \$179,817.61; Equipment Fund: \$30,934.00; Fire Equipment Fund: \$11,823.89; Revaluation Fund: \$90,000.00. Total Town Money: \$685,040.38. Tax Account: \$2,229,220.68.

Maintenance Supervisor Report – Only one storm in January. International needed repair. New truck chassis will not be ready until March, 2027. Oshkosh Truck has been transferred to Kopplin and Kinas. John Deere bucket has been fixed. Pete Stoneberg has been doing work on Wicks Landing. A claim was made to the insurance company because a town plow truck backed into a vehicle. The plow truck had zero damage. The vehicle that was hit had damage. An accident claim is on file.

Public Appearances – Glen Otto appears in regard to the Pye Alley Rd right-of-way. Otto states Lazy L brush has been trimmed. Discussion held.

Payment of Claims – Motion by Allan Weckwerth/Dan Kuglin to pay claims submitted for audit. All ayes. None opposed. Motion carried. General: \$144,854.32 Recycling: \$ 820.00

Award 2026 Old Green Lake Road Project – Five different contractors requested and were provided project specs. Weckwerth explains road construction budget. Discussion held on lending options. Lending options will be placed on the March meeting agenda. Two sealed bids were received for LRIP Project Number 18936 – Old Green Lake Road Project. Name of contractors and bids are read aloud: 1) Kartechner Bros. Construction itemized invoice is read aloud by Chairman Weckwerth. Kartechner Bros submitted a bid of \$972,377.26. 2) Northeast Asphalt itemized invoice is read aloud by Chairman Weckwerth. Northeast submitted a bid of \$858,282.30. Discussion held. There was a sealed bid estimate cost. The bids were less than the estimate. Motion made by Dan Kuglin and seconded by Gary Anderson to accept the low bid from for the LRIP Project 18936 -- Old Green Lake Road from Northeast Asphalt for the total project bid of \$858,282.30. Roll Call Vote: Chairman Weckwerth: Yes; Supervisor 1, Dan Kuglin: Yes; Supervisor 2, Gary Anderson: Yes. None opposed. None abstained. Motion carried.

Discussion on town internet options – Tabled to March meeting. Discussion held on various reasons the town is in need of internet.

Chairman's Report and Correspondence – District Town's Association requested that the town pass a transportation resolution and will be placed on the March meeting agenda. Board of review training paperwork will need to be completed. WTA County Unit Quarterly Meeting will be held April 16, 2026, beginning at 6:30 with a light lunch and meeting to begin at 7:00 pm. Dan Kuglin will look into venues. Revaluation time frame is discussed. Board of Review procedures and ordinances are discussed. Alternates for board of review are discussed. This matter will be placed on the March meeting agenda. Glen Otto inquires on culverts in the town. Discussion held.
