Acceptance of bids for 2025 road projects – Nine entities asked for the bid specifications. Three contractors provided bids: Kartechner Brothers, Northeast Asphalt and Kopplin and Kinas. Chairman Weckwerth reads bids: First bid read is for East Court from Northeast Asphalt for a total of \$28,760.00 for the project. Second bid read is for Oak Road., Fox River Drive and Elm Street (neighborhood of roads) from Kopplin & Kinas for a total of \$319,191.05 for the project. Third bid read is for East Court Drive from Kartechner Brothers for a total of \$29,002.61 for the project. Fourth bid is read for Oak Road, Fox River Drive and Elm Street from Kartechner Brothers for a total of \$396,216.71 for the project. Board discussion held. Motion Dan Kuglin to accept bid for Kartechner for \$29,002.61 and to Kopplin Kinas for Elm, Oak, and Fox River Drive for \$319,191.05. Motion died for lack of a second. Motion Gary Anderson/Dan Kuglin to award bid for East Court to Northeast Asphalt for \$28,760.00 and to Kopplin & Kinas for Oak Road, Fox River Drive and Elm Street for \$319,191.05. All ayes. None opposed. Motion carried.

Chairman's Report and Correspondence — Chairman Weckwerth reads quote for town hall/shed parking lot replacement. Discussion held. New furnace in town hall has been installed. Chairman Weckwerth will send a letter to GFL to notify them that we will be non-renewing the contract with them. The GFL dumpsters will be removed by 3/31/25. Washkovick, Inc. will have their dumpsters at the town hall by 4/1/25.
