June 10, 2026

Regular monthly meeting of the Board of Supervisors, Town of Princeton called to order at 7:00 PM by Chairman Weckwerth. Open meeting laws met through posting and publication. Motion Dan Kuglin/Gary Anderson to approve agenda. All ayes. None opposed. Motion carried. Motion Dan Kuglin/Gary Anderson to approve minutes of the May 13, 2026 meeting as posted. All ayes. None opposed. Motion carried.

Treasurer's Report – Treasurer Wagner gives report. Motion Dan Kuglin/Gary Anderson to approve treasurer's report and submit for audit. All ayes. None opposed. Motion carried. General Account: \$277,555.76; Recycling Account: \$3,667.92; Road Construction: \$179,817.61; Fire Equipment Fund: \$11,823.89; Revaluation Fund: \$29,190.69.

Maintenance Supervisor Report – Chairman Weckwerth gives report. Mowing of ditches has begun. Old Green Lake Rd project is to start Monday, June 15. First windstorm occurred today. Clean-up is underway. Shouldering work has begun. Deer dumpster contact information was obtained and will be posted in town garage. Dumpster will be placed at town dump by July 1. Washkovick, Inc. was awarded deer dumpster contract. Evergreens in right-of-way on South Lakeshore Dr. have been removed; therefore, the court case has been dismissed. Property owners of N4925 Fox River Dr has been noticed by Dempsey Law, town's attorney, to remove vehicles from right-of-way.

Public Appearances – None. Rich Swanke appears inquiring about Losinski Road in regard to road condition. It has been patched and will not be repaved. Discussion held.

Payment of Claims – Motion Dan Kuglin/Gary Anderson to pay claims as submitted. All ayes. None opposed. Motion carried.

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Liquor License Renewal -- Motion Dan Kuglin/Gary Anderson to approve the liquor license renewal, operator licenses and cigarette renewal application for Reilly's 2 Green Lake, LLC and Acorn Ridge Hospitality, LLC, effective July 1, 2026-June 30, 2027. All ayes. None opposed. Motion carried.

Reilly's Pier – Alyse Dzelil appears to request the permission to place the pier in the town access. Motion Dan Kuglin/Gary Anderson to have the town pier put in and removed by Reilly's, and the pier is remain the same length and will removed from site in the fall. All ayes. None opposed. Motion carried.

Seal coat proposal – Beyers Cove – The county fixed their portion. Crack filling needs to be done. Fahrner Asphalt Sealers submitted a quote. This expense will come out of the maintenance budget. Chairman Weckwerth reads quote. Michael Jenquin appeared on

behalf of Fahrner Asphalt and explains quote. Motion Dan Kuglin/Gary Anderson to accept quote from Fahrner Asphalt to do the seal coating and crack filling with granite for \$34,500.00 on Beyers Cove and North Lakeshore Drive, a total of 1.1 miles. All ayes. None opposed. Motion carried.

ATC easement on Oxbow Trail access – There is a power pole on town owned access on Fox River. Chairman Weckwerth reads letter from CBRE in regard to a land easement for power line. More information will be forthcoming. Dempsey Law will review any correspondence that is received.

Chairman's Report and Correspondence – Maintenance of effort reports have been received from EMS and Fire Department Maintenance.

Clerk's Report and Correspondence – Email received from Pat Malone, UW Extension, requesting a survey be completed by board members. The email will be forwarded to board members to complete.
