March 11, 2026

Regular monthly meeting of the Board of Supervisors, Town of Princeton, called to order by Chairman Weckwerth. Open meeting law requirement met through posting and publication. Motion Dan Kuglin/Gary Anderson to approve agenda. All ayes. None opposed. Motion carried. Motion Dan Kuglin/Gary Anderson to approve minutes of the February 11, 2026 meeting minutes as published. All ayes. None opposed. Motion carried.

Treasurer's Report – Treasurer Wagner reads report. Motion Dan Kuglin/Gary Anderson to submit treasurer's report for audit. All ayes. None opposed. Motion carried. General Account: \$278,857.63; Recycling Account: \$1,947.92; Road Construction: \$179,817.61; Equipment Fund: \$0.00; Fire Equipment Fund: \$11,823.89; Revaluation Fund: \$76,348.70. Total Town Money: \$548,265.54. Tax Account: \$172,421.25.

Maintenance Supervisor Report – Snowstorm limb clean up was done. John Deere mower has been repaired and ready for spring. Beaver at Bend Road has finally been trapped. Vehicle in right-of-way on Holmes Road has been removed. Legal notice was published for right-of-way case that is now in circuit court. Defendants emailed a response to court case that has been filed. Weckwerth reads email and explains process. Letter from Green Lake Sanitary District read by Weckwerth indicating Beyers Cove Road will be closed for three weeks due to the sewer extension. Losinski Road patchwork project discussed. LLSIP, Local Small Structures Improvement Program (6-20), structures need to be located and inventoried. Inventory is complete, and the Town of Princeton officially has one that would qualify.

Payment of claims -- Motion by Dan Kuglin/Gary Anderson to pay claims submitted for audit. All ayes. None opposed. Motion carried.

County deer disposal dumpster at town dump – Aaron Wagner appears on behalf of the DOT and Green Lake County. Wagner explains the need for the dumpster and is proposing to use the town's closed landfill to place dumpster on. DOT will be responsible for the dumpster. The county will maintain road and make it passable for trucks. Discussion held. DOT will be drafting and submitting a contract. Motion Dan Kuglin/Allan Weckwerth to allow town to contract with DOT to place dumpster for car versus deer disposal site, with the dumpster being maintained by DOT. Gary Anderson is opposed. Motion carried.

Acorn Ridge Hospitality, LLC outdoor seating proposal -- Mark Wilton explains the amendment he is requesting to expand to outdoor seating directly west, closer to parking lot and motel. Motion Dan Kuglin/Gary Anderson to accept changes requested to allow an outdoor seating area. All ayes. None opposed. Motion carried.

2026 road project bank funding – Chairman Weckwerth reads National Exchange Bank & Trust's funding proposal. A proposal was also received by US Bank which was read aloud at the February, 2026 meeting. Discussion held. Motion Dan Kuglin/Gary Anderson to borrow up to \$600,000 per the terms listed on the loan proposal submitted by National Exchange Bank & Trust. All ayes. None opposed. Motion carried.

Town hall/garage internet need – Verizon, US Cellular/T-Mobile, Starlink and Spectrum are possible options. Internet is need in shop and town hall. Prices will be obtained and tabled until April meeting.

Transportation funding resolution – WTA is asking all municipalities to pass transportation funding solution. Chairman reads resolution. Motion Allan Weckwerth/Gary Anderson to adopt Town of Princeton Transportation Funding Resolution 2026-01. All ayes. None opposed. Motion carried.

Update recycling ordinance – DNR is asking all municipalities to update recycling ordinance. Chairman Weckwerth reads rough draft of recycling ordinance. Motion Dan Kuglin/Gary Anderson to pass Ordinance 2026-01 with the changes made. All ayes. None opposed. Motion carried. Ordinance will be prepared for signature at the April meeting.

WTA unit host details – Meeting is to be held at the VFW on April 16, 2026 with a light lunch at 6:30 pm to be catered by Crossroads. The meeting will begin at 7:00 pm. Guest speaker will be Attorney Larry Konopacki, lobbyist for municipalities.

Board of Review alternates – Rose Wick and Becky Wagner have agreed to be alternates for 2026 Board of Review.

Chairman's Report and Correspondence – Sanitary District will chemically treat Beyer's Cove again this year.

Clerk's Report and Correspondence – Spring Election will be held on Tuesday, April 7, 2026, from 7:00 am to 8:00 pm. Early in person voting is by appointment only to begin on March 23, 2026, through Thursday, April 2, 2026.
