Chairman's Report and Correspondence – Town of Princeton applied for and was awarded TRIP S Town Road Improvement Supplement Program for 2024-2025 for Old Green Lake Road. Weckwerth reads award letter. Award total was 1.2 million dollars budgeted project with \$840,000 to be reimbursed by the Department of Transportation. This project will be done in 2026. The total mileage for this project is 3.5 miles. GL Sanitary District is applying chemicals in Beyers Cove for weed control. Weckwerth has been certified for chemical application for ditches. Open Book was held on 5/3/24. Board of Review will be held on 5/21/24 from 5-7 pm. Stott delinquent personal property is discussed. WiFi hotspot will be needed for reevaluation year. This will be tabled to a future meeting.
